Here are some of our top picks for places to stay in the area.

1) [Brokerswood Country Park](#)

Brokerswood Country Park is set in beautiful woodlands with a tranquil lake and fishing sites nearby. Just twelve miles south of Bath, it is perfectly situated to explore the beautiful ancient town. There's plenty to keep the whole family amused moments away from the site, including adventure playgrounds and a play trail for the younger children as well as charming local pubs for the adults. The extensive onsite amenities include a restaurant, food shop and launderette.

2) [Salisbury Camping and Caravanning Club](#)

Salisbury Camping and Caravanning Club Site is situated on the outskirts of the beautiful city of Salisbury. Perfect for a culturally rich trip, Salisbury's 13th century gothic cathedral is just minutes away and a bus to Stonehenge ancient monument stops directly outside the site. For those who simply want to enjoy the beautiful countryside, Hudson's Field is located adjacent to the site and is perfect for long walks and kite-flying.

3) [Devizes Camping and Caravanning Club Site](#)

Devizes Camping and Caravanning Club is a beautiful tree-lined site on the Kenning and Avon canal. The site is located a short walk away from the pretty market town of Devizes which is home to one of the finest prehistoric museums in Europe. There is plenty close-by to entertain the family including Longleat, star of the BBC's Animal Park, which is home to 900 acres of parkland and a breathtaking selection of wildlife.

4) [Coombe Caravan Park](#)

Coombe Caravan Park is a pleasant family run site offering some of the best views in Wiltshire. The Park overlooks the Chalke Valley and is set alongside Sailisbury Racecourse. Perfect for sports lovers, there is an eighteen-hole golf course nearby, as well as tennis courts and horse riding. The site also offers excellent amenities such as free hot water showers, an onsite shop, laundry and post box.

5) [Piccadilly Caravan Park](#)

Piccadilly Caravan Park is a small family run site, situated in countryside close to National Trust village of Lacock. The village is home to the stunning 13th century Abbey and Cloisters, as featured in the Harry Potter Films. Perfect for those wanting to escape city life, there is also an 18th century summer house and beautiful rose garden. The caravan park has excellent amenities such as an on-site play area, launderette, showers and electrical hook-up points for tourers.
