Every Friday 9.45am to 11am. Memorial Hall, The Borough, Downton

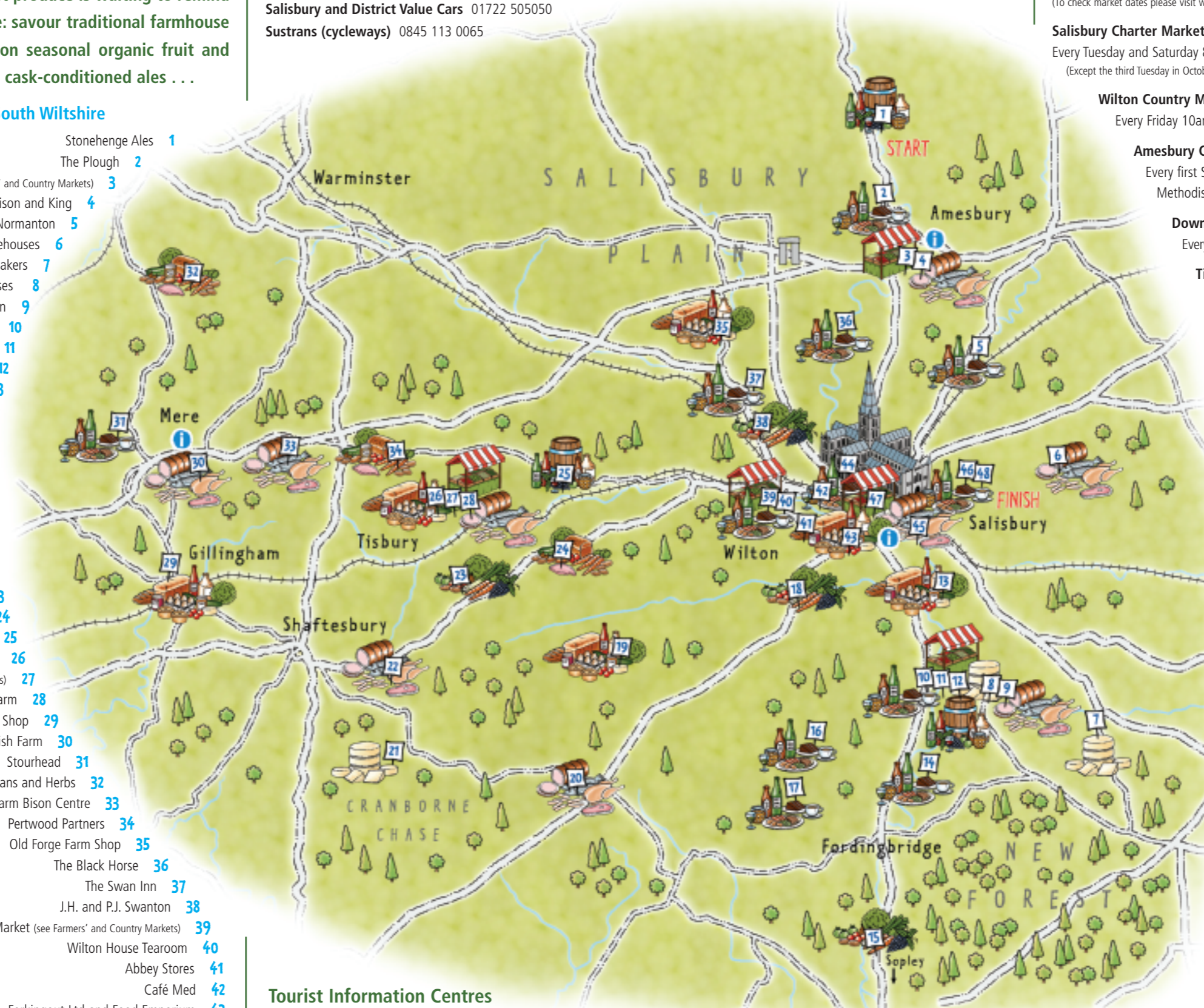
