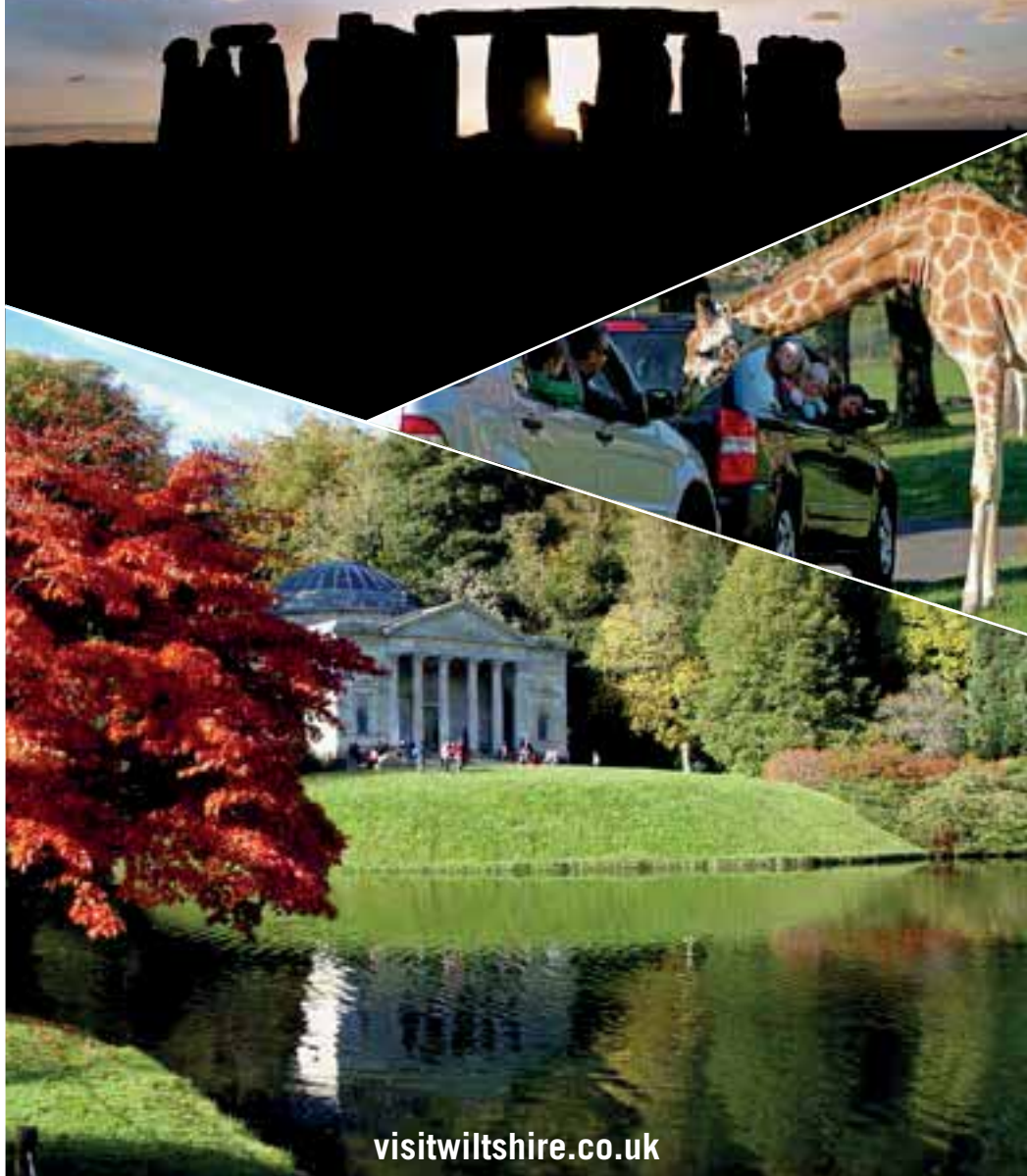

Garden enthusiasts are in for a real treat in 2016, as not only is this the Year of the English Garden, it is also the 300th anniversary of the birth of master landscaper Lancelot 'Capability' Brown. Stately homes and gardens around the county will be celebrating these horticultural highlights, giving you more reasons than ever to visit Wiltshire in 2016.

The breathtaking settings of Bowood and Longleat owe much to the genius and vision of 'Capability' Brown, while his influence can also be seen at Corsham Court, Lacock, Old Wardour and Wilton House. Other properties where outstanding gardens provide the perfect backdrop to the homes of the well-to-do include Stourhead, Great Chalfield Manor, Mompesson House and Arundells. These are the perfect places to connect with the past while enjoying the present.

The **Timeless Wonders** of Stonehenge and Avebury, along with other ancient structures such as West Kennet Long Barrow and Silbury Hill, make up Wiltshire's World Heritage Site and are worthy of a place on any itinerary. So too is Salisbury Cathedral, where you will find the tallest spire in Britain and the best preserved original 1215 Magna Carta.

**Timeless Places** you won't want to miss include world-class museums, impressive castles, attractions from the age of industry and others offering close encounters with members of the animal kingdom. In fact, 2016 also sees the 50th anniversary of the opening of the UK's first safari park at Longleat.

Set in a **Timeless Landscape**, the medieval city of Salisbury offers the perfect fusion of ancient and modern, while each of Wiltshire's historic towns and villages has a range of **Timeless Pleasures** to enjoy, from stylish independent shops and colourful markets, to tempting pubs and restaurants, exciting activities or great entertainment. Many, including the honey-coloured gem of Bradford on Avon, have interesting architecture reflecting their textile heritage.

All the information in this guide has been compiled with groups in mind, from ideas for refreshment stops and places to stay, to information on festivals and events, details of special offers, and advice on coach parking. Join in the nationwide celebrations in 2016 by bringing your group to Wiltshire to find out more about the life and work of Lancelot 'Capability' Brown.

This NEW **Bowood** and **Longleat** one-day package is a perfect group day out for horticultural enthusiasts or anyone interested in historic houses and gardens.

**Morning:** Arrive at **Bowood House and Gardens** for tea or coffee before enjoying a 90-minute tour of the 'Capability' Brown landscape with an expert guide. Bowood's flowing mix of woodlands and lawns leading down to the lake are a fitting setting for the impressive 18th century house designed by Robert Adam.

**Lunch:** A delicious pre-booked two course buffet lunch can be served in the Stables Restaurant; alternatively, visitors can purchase their own lunch from the Treehouse Café.

**Afternoon:** Leave Bowood at 1pm for the drive to **Longleat** (55 minutes/25 miles) where you will enjoy a 90-minute guided tour of the formal gardens, Secret Garden and Pleasure Walk.

Afterwards you can explore the magnificent stately home, an outstanding example of high Elizabethan architecture, and finish with a scrumptious cream tea in the beautiful Orangery before you depart.

## WORLD HERITAGE WONDERS – 2 days

Avebury • West Kennet Long Barrow • Silbury Hill  
• Wiltshire Museum • Amesbury History Centre • Stonehenge • The Salisbury Museum

### Day 1

**Morning:** Your day begins at **Avebury**, which lies at the centre of a prehistoric complex in the **North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty** and is the largest stone circle in the world. Whilst here, be sure to visit the **Alexander Keiller Museum**, before moving on to explore **West Kennet Long Barrow** nearby and pausing to view the mysterious, man-made mound of **Silbury Hill**. As you travel across Wiltshire, keep a look out for our famous **White Horses**, carved into the rolling chalk hillsides.

**Lunch:** Calne or Devizes areas

**Afternoon:** Spend a fascinating afternoon at **Wiltshire Museum** in Devizes, where you will find galleries spanning Neolithic, Bronze Age, Iron Age, Roman, Saxon and Medieval times, including Gold from the Time of Stonehenge.

**Overnight:** Amesbury or Salisbury areas – **The Cathedral Hotel** in Salisbury is one option

### Day 2

**Morning:** First call today is **Amesbury History Centre** to see one of the UK's largest collections of Mesolithic finds. Then on to iconic **Stonehenge** which, along with Avebury, forms part of Wiltshire's World Heritage Site. Outstanding exhibitions in the Stonehenge visitor centre explain the monument's historic context. Pre-bookable tours are available with one of our local guides (see pages 58-59).

**Lunch:** Amesbury or Salisbury areas - **The Stonehenge Inn** is one of the closest to Stonehenge.

**Afternoon:** Round off the day at **The Salisbury Museum** which houses one of Europe's most extensive collections of finds from Stonehenge, as well as the Monckton Deverill Gold Torc and the grave of the Amesbury Archer, the richest Beaker burial in Britain.

### MAGNA CARTA TRAIL – 2 days

Salisbury • Salisbury Cathedral • Stonehenge • Trowbridge  
**Day 1**

*Morning:* Start the morning at **Salisbury Cathedral**, home to the finest preserved of only four original 1215 Magna Carta manuscripts. An informative exhibition in the magnificent Chapter House sets the Charter in its historical context and explains its enduring significance in the 21st century. After elevenses at one of the cafés in the Close, visit another of the attractions there (see below).

*Lunch:* Salisbury

*Afternoon:* As well as the Cathedral, the beautiful medieval city of **Salisbury** offers a wealth of fascinating attractions including **Arundells**, **The Salisbury Museum**, **Mompesson House** and **The Rifles Berkshire & Wiltshire Museum**. This afternoon offers the ideal opportunity to visit one or more of them. Just a short stroll away, in the city centre, you will also find an excellent range of independent shops, a twice-weekly market (on Tuesdays and Saturdays), plenty of pubs and restaurants to choose from and excellent year-round entertainment.

*Overnight:* Salisbury or Amesbury areas

### Day 2

*Morning:* Just 20 minutes from Salisbury, **Stonehenge** is believed by archaeologists to have evolved between 3,000 BC and 1,600 BC. Along with **Avebury** it forms part of Wiltshire's World Heritage Site. As well as the stone circle itself, be sure to visit the outstanding exhibitions in the Stonehenge visitor centre which set this iconic monument in its historic context.

*Lunch:* Trowbridge

*Afternoon:* Henry de Bohun from **Trowbridge** was one of the 25 barons elected to enforce Magna Carta in the early 13th century. Trowbridge was Henry's caput, or headquarters and he is pictured in a stained glass window in St James's Church, holding a copy of the Charter.

### INDUSTRIAL AND AVIATION HERITAGE – 3+ days

Kennet & Avon Canal • Crofton Beam Engines • Wilton Windmill • STEAM Museum • Malmesbury • Corsham • Wadworth Brewery • Bradford on Avon • Trowbridge • Trowbridge Museum • Fleet Air Arm Museum

### Day 1

*Morning:* Start your visit at **Crofton Pumping Station** near Marlborough and discover magnificent 200-year-old working steam engines. On Sundays and Bank Holiday Mondays you can also visit nearby **Wilton Windmill**.

*Lunch:* Marlborough or Pewsey areas

*Afternoon:* Take a step back in time at **STEAM – Museum of the Great Western Railway** in Swindon.

*Overnight:* Malmesbury area

### Day 2

*Morning:* Uncover the history of fine lace making at the Athelstan Museum in **Malmesbury**, before moving on to honey-coloured **Corsham** which owed its former prosperity to the wool trade.

*Lunch:* Corsham or Devizes areas

*Afternoon:* Discover the history and heritage of brewing on a tour of **Wadworth Brewery** and maybe enjoy a boat trip on the **Kennet & Avon Canal**.

*Overnight:* Bradford on Avon or Trowbridge areas

### Day 3

*Morning:* Many buildings in **Bradford on Avon** reflect its textile heritage, including Abbey Mill and former weavers' cottages.

*Lunch:* Bradford on Avon

*Afternoon:* In **Trowbridge** the woollen cloth industry left a rich architectural legacy and **Trowbridge Museum** continues the theme with a nationally important collection relating to West Country woollen cloth production.

If you are able to stay an extra day, **Fleet Air Arm Museum** near Yeovilton tells the story of the Royal Navy in the air.

### Day 1

*Morning:* Visit beautiful **Larmer Tree** recognised by English Heritage as a Garden of National Importance.

*Lunch:* Tisbury or Mere areas.

*Afternoon:* Travel across **Cranborne Chase and West Wiltshire Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty**, to the famous 18th century gardens at **Stourhead** with their lake and classical temples. For much of the year the Palladian House is also open.

*Overnight:* Warminster or Westbury areas

### Day 2:

*Morning:* The delightful **Peto Garden at Iford Manor** is an Edwardian version of Tuscany, with romantic, Italianate gardens cut into the hillside.

*Lunch:* Bradford on Avon area

*Afternoon:* Discover the charming Arts and Crafts garden at 15th century **Great Chalfield Manor**, near Melksham.

As you travel on from here, the Cotswold village of **Castle Combe** makes a delightful stopping-off-point.

*Overnight:* Malmesbury area – the **Best Western Mayfield House Hotel** is one option

### Day 3:

*Morning:* Start your day in the centre of medieval Malmesbury at **Abbey House Gardens**, set in five spectacular acres, straddling the river.

*Lunch:* Malmesbury area

*Afternoon:* Your tour ends just over the county boundary at **Westonbirt, The National Arboretum**, a carefully designed Victorian landscape in the Cotswolds.

Pre-book a tower tour for wide-ranging views across the city and surrounding water-meadows. After elevenses at one of several cafés in the Close, visit any of the other attractions there:

**Arundells**, the home of former Prime Minister Sir Edward Heath, reflects his time in public life and offers access to the beautiful two-acre garden; **The Salisbury Museum** houses world-class archaeology collections, including one of Europe's most extensive collections of Stonehenge and prehistoric artefacts; the National Trust's **Mompesson House** is the perfect Queen Anne townhouse, with a delightful walled garden; while **The Rifles Berkshire & Wiltshire Museum** is three attractions in one: part military museum, part historic house and part riverside garden.

*Lunch:* Salisbury

*Afternoon:* Pay a visit to another of the Close attractions listed above. Then head into the city centre to discover a range of unique, independent shops, including **Fisherton Mill** with its gallery, café and artist studios. On Tuesdays and Saturdays (except the third Tuesday in October) the Charter Market comes to town, and if you visit between late-November and mid-December Salisbury's enchanting **Christmas Market** will be in full swing.

*Evening:* Those able to stay on into the evening can choose from a wide range of excellent entertainment at **Salisbury Playhouse**, the south west's leading producing theatre, or **City Hall**, Salisbury's largest live entertainment venue. If you need help getting around while you are here, contact **Salisbury Value Cars** for taxi services.

## SAINTS AND SINNERS – 1 to 4 days

A heritage trail combining inspiring churches and devilishly good food... visit them all or cherry pick the ones that fit in best with your itinerary. Further information can be found at [visitchurches.org.uk/saintsandsinnerswiltshire](http://visitchurches.org.uk/saintsandsinnerswiltshire)

### Option 1

**All Saints', Alton Priors:** With a 1,700 year old yew tree in the churchyard and hidden Sarsen stones in the nave, this peaceful 12th century church enjoys terrific views of the Alton Barnes White Horse. **The Red Lion Freehouse, East Chisenbury:** A village pub with a Michelin Star, located on the edge of Salisbury Plain, just 15 minutes from Stonehenge.

### Option 2

**St Leonard's, Sutton Veny:** Now mostly an atmospheric ruin, but in a gorgeous location on the edge of this picture-postcard village, surrounded by a park-like churchyard, open fields and foot and cycle paths. **The Beckford Arms:** A traditional yet stylish country inn on the edge of the Fonthill Estate, offering great food in a classic pub environment.

### Option 3

**St Mary's, Old Dilton:** Dating from the 14th-century, little has changed inside St Mary's since the 18th century, with bleached box pews, a three-decker pulpit, family pews and railed galleries intact. **The Three Daggers, Edington:** Great tasting food, using locally sourced produce. As well as the pub, you can also visit the farm shop (stocked with produce from their own farm) and brewery, both on site.

### Option 4

**St John the Baptist Church, Inglesham:** An exquisitely beautiful 13th century church, saved by pioneering Victorian designer William Morris who oversaw its restoration and kept its medieval identity. **Stanton House Hotel, Stanton Fitzwarren:** An ideal spot to take in the wonderful Wiltshire countryside, whilst sampling Japanese cuisine or traditional cream teas on the terrace.

The Great West Way runs right across Wiltshire, from Hungerford on the Berkshire border to Bath on the boundary with Somerset. Along the way it gives you the chance to visit some of Wiltshire's most charming towns and villages. Follow the route by coach or car, or travel by rail, by bicycle, on foot or by canal boat. Take a direct route, or add in a few detours ... it's up to you!

*Marlborough:* This handsome former staging post in the **North Wessex Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty** has evolved into a stylish and cosmopolitan town with its own chic café culture. Nearby are the World Heritage Site of **Avebury, West Kennet Long Barrow** and **Silbury Hill**.

## TRAVEL THE KENNET & AVON CANAL – 1 to 3 days

Bradford on Avon • Devizes • Vale of Pewsey

Running right across the centre of Wiltshire, the **Kennet & Avon Canal** makes a relaxing and unhurried way to enjoy the county's timeless scenery. Originally used to transport goods and materials during the industrial revolution, today it makes a soothing backdrop for walking and cycling along the towpath. You can travel along its length under your own steam or, if time is short, go by road from town to town, stopping off wherever you please. If you fancy taking to the water, the Kennet & Avon Canal Trust runs boat trips from both Bradford on Avon and Devizes.

**Day 1:** Your journey starts at **Bradford on Avon** on the western border of Wiltshire. Perched on the edge of the Cotswolds, this honey-coloured gem is packed with buildings from centuries past, many of which reflect its textile heritage. Highlights include the ancient town bridge, the Saxon Church and the 14th century Tithe Barn. **The Bridge Tea Rooms** make a great place for a pit stop.

*Overnight:* Bradford on Avon or Devizes areas

**Day 2:** Devizes is home to both **Wadworth Brewery Visitor Centre** and the **Wiltshire Museum**. On the outskirts of the town you will find the flight of 29 consecutive locks at Caen Hill, an astonishing feat of canal engineering. If you head to the Wharf you will find the Canal Museum which tells the story of the Kennet & Avon Canal from construction, through near demise, to restoration.

*Overnight:* Devizes or Pewsey areas

**Day 3:** In addition to its own wharf on the Kennet & Avon Canal, the **Vale of Pewsey** offers charming thatched cottages, churches dating from Saxon times, and a wide range of places to eat and drink. There is a Heritage Centre in Pewsey itself, while other attractions in the area include **Wilton Windmill**, the only working windmill in Wessex, and the magnificent 200-year-old working beam engines at **Crofton Pumping Station**.

# FAVOURITE SCREEN LOCATIONS

Wiltshire has taken centre stage in a wide range of productions from swashbuckling adventures to Jane Austen classics, *Hogwarts to Wolf Hall*. The following is just a small selection of big screen movies and TV costume dramas filmed around the county – for more information go to [www.visitwiltshire.co.uk/film](http://www.visitwiltshire.co.uk/film)

**Downton Abbey (2015):** Filming for the sixth and final series of this hit TV series took place in the National Trust village of Lacock, much to the delight of visiting tourists.

**Poldark (2015):** This major BBC series starring Aidan Turner may have been set in Cornwall, but it was the charming Wiltshire market town of Corsham that location scouts selected as the perfect match for 18th century Truro in series one. Great Chalfield Manor features in series two.

**Wolf Hall (2015):** In this BBC serialisation of Hilary Mantel's novel, the exterior of Lacock Abbey represented Wolf Hall, the Seymour family seat, while the interiors of fellow National Trust property Great Chalfield Manor stood in for Austin Friars, home of Thomas Cromwell.

**War Horse (2011):** Often referred to as 'the prettiest village in England', stunning Castle Combe played a major role in *War Horse* and also featured in *Stardust*, *The Wolf Man* and *Dr Dolittle*.

**The Young Victoria (2009):** In Momentum Pictures' film about the life of Queen Victoria, Wilton House doubled not only as Prince Albert's home, Rosenau Castle, but also as Buckingham Palace.

**Harry Potter & The Half Blood Prince (2009) / Harry Potter & The Chamber of Secrets (2002):** Sequences from both of these family favourites were filmed at Lacock Abbey, including scenes where its cloisters represented the corridors at Hogwarts.

**Lark Rise to Candleford (2008–2011):** Locations near Corsham in north Wiltshire featured in this popular BBC costume drama.

**Cranford (2007):** The village of Lacock, with its cottages and inns dating back to the 15th century was the backdrop to this BBC production.

**Pride & Prejudice (2005):** In this cinema version of the Jane Austen classic, starring Keira Knightley and Matthew Macfadyen, viewers will recognise not only Wilton House – which doubled as Pemberley, the family seat of Mr Darcy – but also the magnificent gardens at Stourhead, where Elizabeth Bennett initially rejects his proposal of marriage.

**Chocolat (2000):** River scenes from this film featuring Juliette Binoche and Johnny Depp were filmed at Fonthill Lake, near the charming village of Fonthill Bishop.

**Sense & Sensibility (1995):** The National Trust's Mompesson House in Salisbury's Cathedral Close achieved celebrity status as the London home of Mrs Jennings, while the Double Cube Room at Wilton House was used for ballroom scenes in the film.

Other big screen films featuring Wiltshire locations include *The Wolfman* (2010), *The Other Boleyn Girl* (2008) and *Saving Private Ryan* (1998).

TV series filmed here include *Doctor Who* (2010), *The Victorian Farm* (2009), *Tess of the d'Urbervilles* (2008) and various episodes of *Time Team*.

In addition, Salisbury Cathedral was the inspiration behind TV mini-series *Pillars of the Earth*, based on the best-selling book by Ken Follett and shown in the UK in 2013.

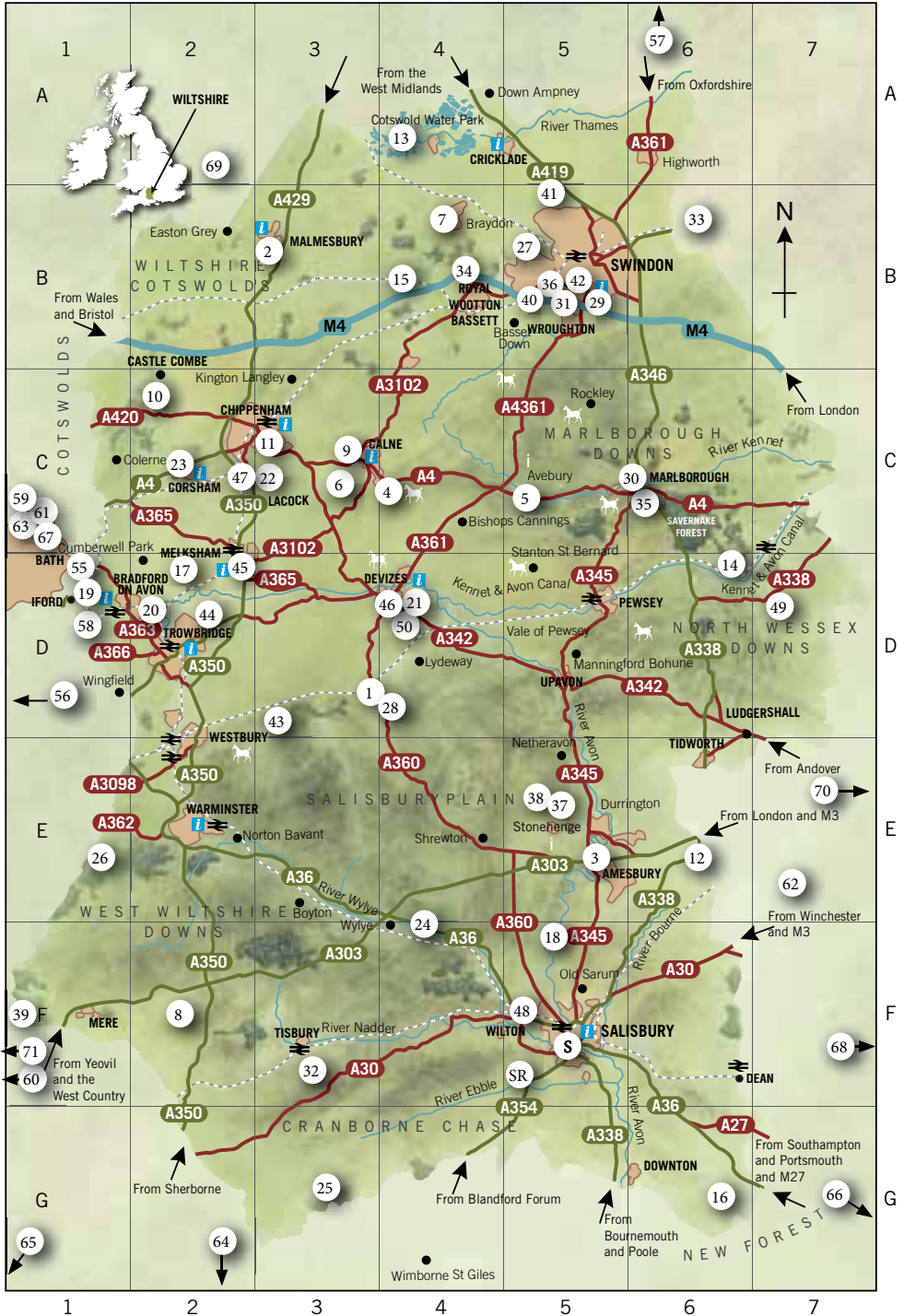
