National Trust's **Stourhead House and Gardens** are open with selected showrooms ornately decorated for Christmas. Visitors can discover how the Hoare family celebrated Christmas through the ages. Explore the beautiful gardens complete with Gothic Cottage and a warming log fire. 2 or 3 course lunches can be prebooked for groups. At **Salisbury Cathedral** you can witness the spectacular Darkness to Light Advent Procession on 26 and 27 November, as 13,000 candles light up the cathedral. Arundells is a hidden gem, where visitors can explore the home of former Prime Minister Sir Edward Heath and find out more about the man who was an amazing musician, sailor and art collector. Events and Entertainment

Wiltshire's rural market towns have many Christmas events and festivities including **Malmesbury's** Community Choir Christmas Concert on 3 December and the Malmesbury Singers Christmas Concert on 10 December, plus late night shopping on 2 December. On Saturday 26 November in **Corsham**, you can write a wish, pop it in bauble and hang it on Corsham's High Street Christmas tree for Father Christmas to collect when he's passing. It's free and open for wishes from 10am-1pm. Corsham's Christmas Lights Switch on is on 2 December from 5pm with music, entertainment, Christmas market, reindeer and, of course, a very special visitor in his grotto. **Bradford-on-Avon's** Christmas light switch on will be on 25 November at 6pm.

This year's **Wyvern Theatre** pantomime is the enchanting tale of Cinderella, which takes to the stage from Saturday 10 December to Sunday 8 January. Special group rates from only £17.50 apply for bookings of 8+ people. The Wyvern will also be hosting a selection of hospitality events, from 'Festive Tea and Tours' to 'Dick Whittington's Dinner Invite' and 'Murder at the Panto', a special festive take on the Murder Mystery Dinner. www.swindontheatres.co.uk
