

'Wiltshire on the Great West Way®' Familiarisation Visit 19 September-19 October 2022

The 'Wiltshire on the Great West Way® self-drive familiarisation visit this autumn, is an opportunity for group travel organisers, coach and tour operators to recce some of the amazing places to visit and things to do in Wiltshire, with a view to bringing your group in the future and/or packaging and selling the county to your customers.
