

Wiltshire Highlights

- Bowood House and Gardens Groups of 15 people + can have exclusive-use of The Garden's Bothy, where refreshments can be served or specialist talks or demonstrations can take place. Choose from a Bowood House tour (1hr), Private Walled Garden tour (1 hr), Capability Brown parkland tour (1½hrs) or 'Dr. Joeseph Priestly: The Discovery of Oxygen' tour (1hr).
- Salisbury Cathedral The 15th Century Library is now open for small group tours (max 12 people). Built in 1455 the library contains over 10,000 books dating as far back as the 9th Century. Library Tours start at 14:00 and last approximately 45 minutes followed by delicious cream tea at 15:00 in the Cathedral's Refectory Restaurant. Groups with a head for heights can take a Tower Tour to the base of Britain's tallest spire (404ft/123m) or view medieval Arabic carpentry markings on a Graffiti Tour.
- Longleat Discover Longleat House and Grounds with a number of fascinating tours, exclusive to groups. Choose from 'Longleat House Exclusive Tour', 'Butlers & Housekeepers Tour' or 'Scandalous History Tour'.
- Additional Special Interest Tours including TV & Film locations, town & city tours, history & heritage tours are available. Book a Wiltshire Tour at www.visitwiltshire.co.uk/groups
- Lacock Abbey's new theme for 2018 will be 'Women of Lacock', featuring four different key
 women and their influence on the village, with interpretation and events throughout the year.
 They have also just opened a new upmarket tea room serving high tea for groups.



England's Great West Way

VisitWiltshire are working to create one of the world's premier touring routes between London and Bristol. This is one of a number of successful projects made possible by HM Government's £40m Discover England Fund, administered by VisitEngland (www.discoverenglandfund.org).

The Great West Way follows a 125-mile route - a quarter of which is in Wiltshire - based on one of the first Great Roads commissioned by the Kings of England. It offers an extraordinary variety of English experiences not found in any other part of the country.

Visitors will be able to explore by road – coach and car, railway, waterway or by walking or cycling. It is for curious and inquisitive travelers. Those who like to go deeper, to see, feel, do, try and taste for themselves. It's for seekers searching for the real, authentic essence of England.

The Great West Way will promote a range of product themes reflecting the route's tourism assets including history and heritage, food and drink, countryside, film tourism, gardens and luxury tourism.
