13 6.5Km / 4 MILES 2 HOURS EASY Walk

LOWER WOODFORD VALLEY





This is a short walk with two river crossings, capturing some of the best river and architectural views of the Woodford Valley.

The walk



With the Wheatsheaf Inn behind you, turn L and walk north through the village. After 500 yds turn L into a road opposite a thatched wall and walk up towards the farm buildings.

2 0.9km/½ mile

By a farm cottage turn L over a stile and follow the fence line on the L. Pass over two more stiles with a wooden fence on your R. Where the wood fence ends, continue straight on across an open field. Cross over a farm track and continue on to the far hedge.

Turn R and walk up the line of a new hedge.

3 2km/11/4 miles

After 50 yds, by a wildlife information board and footpath sign, turn L and drop down and across the main road. Follow the earth track opposite past Bays House. Turn L over a stile and then R along the field edge parallel with the stream. Cross over two more stiles turning L over a third stile and then R and head up towards a white gate leading to Keepers Cottage. a private road.

4 2.5km/1½ miles

Turn L onto the tarmac private road and head towards Little Durnford Manor. Cross over the river bridge and follow the road round to the R and then turn L by a barn. Pass the manor house on your L, watching out for the camel and alpacas in the fields to your R. As you approach some estate cottages you will see a white door ahead - pass through it and continue across the main road leading up a private road signed to

Walk up the tree-lined avenue until the road intersects a bridleway at Keepers Cottage. Turn L and head up hill. After ½ mile the track narrows to a path through a small section of wood and crosses over the Monarch's Way (a long-distance trail of 610 miles which closely follows the meandering route taken by Charles II after his defeat at the Battle of Worcester in 1651). On emerging from the wood, follow the blue (bridleway) arrow and head north

6 6km/3¾ miles

After 1/4 mile you will come to a farm track leading to Salterton Farm, Turn L and head down hill through the farmyard. Turn L onto the main road and after 50 yds turn R by a post box and head down the tarmac path towards the River Avon, Cross over three small footbridges and pass by a large house on your L. Cross over the cattle grid ahead and turn L on the main road, heading back to the start,
