- Add a two-hour premium garden tour for £34 per person (minimum charge £600)

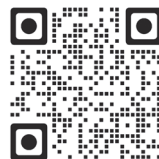
Specialist catering options available:

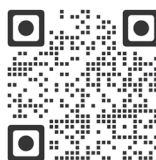
